Communication	All registered teams will be contacted by the LOC at their registered address and sent the programme and protection concept.						
Protective equipment	 All participants and visitors are responsible for their own protective equipment (masks, disinfectants) and will bring these with themselves. Disinfectants are also provided in the common rooms. 						
Contact Tracing	 Distribution to the common rooms. The list with contact details must be stored until 14 days after the event and must be identifiable at the request of the cantonal health authorities. Registration takes place via the Mindful app https://mindfulapp.io/#download. The QR codes will be displayed at the entrance to the competition site. Everyone must log out of the Mindful app when leaving the competition area. If electronic contact tracing is not possible with the Mindful app, the team captain must keep a manual list of his athletes and staff and hand them over at the team captain meeting.
