
Zagreb – city with a million hearts

The city of Zagreb, capital of Croatia, on the historic and political threshold between East and West, illustrates both the continental and Mediterranean spirit of the nation it spearheads. Zagreb is the cultural, scientific, economic, political and administrative centre of the Republic of

Croatia, and is home to the Croatian Parliament, Government and President. Its favourable location between the Pannonian plain, the edge of the Alps and the Dinaric range has allowed it to become a crossing point for mass international communication.

The city is protected from the cold northern winds by the mountain of Medvednica and opens up to the rest of the world thanks to a spacious plain and the Sava river. Zagreb, with a population of nearly one million, contains almost a quarter of the entire population of Croatia. Over the centuries, the city was inhabited by people coming from all over Europe; and, in recent years, by people coming from different parts of Croatia, ensuring a rich cultural life. Zagreb is a safe city whose doors are always open; a city with a tumultuous history teeming with interesting personalities;

a city that warmly invites all those who wish to get to know it, and a city that will



surely fulfill your expectations. In this city, you can easily meet remarkable people, make new friends and enjoy special moments. The façades of Zagreb's buildings reflect the ebb and flow of history, while its streets and squares bear witness to the coming together of the many cultures that have shaped the identity of this laid-back capital. The best thing to do is when you first arrive is to take in Zagreb's wonderful atmosphere, which, as many claim, is only surpassed by the legendary beauty of the local womenfolk.









### Ski resort Sljeme



Croatian capital Zagreb can boast with having a ski resort situated only about twenty minutes car ride from the city center. On the ski slopes of mountain Medvednica the best Croatian skiers, Janica and Ivica Kostelic, made their first ski steps on their journey to ski fame.

Ski slopes and ski lifts are situated on the peak ridge and on the north slopes of mountain Medvednica. The ski slopes begin almost on the very top of the mountain and continue to spread gently across the peak ridge on the Bijela livada (White Meadow) towards east and steeply towars north on the Crveni spust (Red Slope). Next to the Crveni spust (Red Slope) on the north side of the ridge there are also Zeleni (Green), Plavi (Blue) and Bijeli (White) Slopes. Total length of the slopes is about 4.000 meters.

There are two T-bar ski lifts (on the White and Green Slopes) and a three-chairlift (on the Red Slope), which have а total capacity of about 3.300 skiers per hour. Crveni (Red) Slope, Bijela livada (White Meadow), Zeleni (Green) Slope and parts of the Plavi (Blue) Slope are equipped with snowmaking facilities. A lighting system allows for night skiing on the Crveni (Red) Slope and Bijela livada (White Meadow).

Every skiing season there are a number of skiing competitions held on the ski slopes of Sljeme, among which the most famous and the most prestigious is the <u>FIS World Ski Cup competition</u>.









#### Accommodation info:

Hotel Tomislavov dom has only one room adopted for wheelchair users. Please, note that all other rooms are not adapted for wheelchair users. The bathroom doors are not wide enough for the wheelchairs.

#### System of hotel reservation will be on a first-come, first-served basis.

Hotel Tomislavov dom is located in the close vicinity of Zagreb, at 1000 meters above sea level, surrounded by a hundred-year-old forest and only 20 minutes away from the heart of the city.

Located in the nature park Medvednica, "Tomislavac" is an ideal destination for an active holiday, relaxing in extra facilities, but also business meetings. There are 42 rooms in the hotel, including one adapted for people with special needs. Each room has a shower and a toilet, TV/SAT, mini bar, a hair dryer and Internet



connection. The rooms are decorated according to the highest hotel and esthetic standards.

Apart from comfortable accommodation services, the hotel offers an extra facilities like fitness, sauna, jacuzzi and the swimming pool with an option of swimming against the water current.
