COVID 19 Information:	<p align="center">MANDATORY VACCINATION FOR PARTICIPATION</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The event requires all participants including athletes, coaches, service and team personnel, volunteers and officials to be fully vaccinated for COVID-19 as per the Canadian standards for vaccination. These standards are having received the full series of an accepted Canadian COVID-19 vaccine or a full series of a combination of accepted vaccines. You MUST have received your last dose at least 14 full days prior to the commencement of the event. IMPORTANT: All participants MUST fill out the COVID waiver within 48hrs of the first TC meeting: Participation Agreement: 2021 Para Alpine Race Series (alpinepoints.ca). Failure to execute the waiver or falsely complete the waiver will leave the individual in-eligible to participate in the competition. Anyone under the age of 18 MUST have their legal guardian execute the waiver. It is an individual's requirement to be aware of and adhere to all COVID-19 rules and regulations for accommodations and the resort venue. In addition to any resort policies, all event participants will be required to practice social distancing and wear a face covering whilst on resort premises, including riding chairlifts and within the field of play, except when an athlete is on their competition run. The COVID-19 officer will be identified at the 1st Team Captains' meeting and available for connection for the duration of the event. Masks MUST be worn at all times whilst in the wax trailer facilities.

Covid Vaccine Requirement for the Panorama WPAS and NorAm events:

Alpine Canada is committed to creating a healthy, inclusive and safe sport environment. It is the foundation for a culture of excellence where our athletes, teams, coaches, staff and volunteers can be at their very best. Accordingly ACA has implemented a mandatory COVID-19 vaccination policy which will be in effect for the 2021 World Para-Alpine WPAS and NorAm events in Panorama, November 24-26, 2021.



All volunteers, coaches, athletes and support staff will be required to be fully vaccinated (2 weeks post 2nd dose) with a Canadian approved vaccine, prior to their arrival at the event. Note that local regulations at the time of the event may also require masking and other measures in some indoor and outdoor environments.

Alpine Canada and the Para-Alpine Event team will remain in touch with volunteers as the event gets closer to update all individuals on any changes or specific new requirements for volunteering at the event.

Thank you for your interest in volunteering and understanding our commitment to the health and safety of others as we return to the competitive sport environment.
