VEYSONNAZ, AN ESSENTIAL STEP IN THE WORLD CUP



A DESTINATION IN THE HEART OF THE ALPS

Veysonnaz is a small authentic village located in the heart of the Valais Alps in a sumptuous setting just 13km from Sion. In Veysonnaz, a human-sized and friendly village, people take the time to talk to each other. One of the greatest riches of the region is undoubtedly its privileged location. Perched like an eagle's nest on a beautiful side of the mountains, Veysonnaz can enjoy optimal sunshine (on average 300 days per year) and its view overlooking the Rhone Valley is dizzily marvellous. In the old village, the typical chalets and its inhabitants will charm you.

As the Capital of Valais, Sion offers to its inhabitants and its visitors a southern art of living and a conviviality which make it a privileged place for the 4-season tourism. Two castles dominate the old town and its picturesque streets: Tourbillon, built at the end of the 13th century by the Prince-Bishop of Sion, and the Basilica of Valère, which houses the oldest playable organ in the world. Sion is also focused on innovation, with the first autonomous shuttles integrated into traffic as well as the Campus Energypolis, which will have brought together a thousand specialists in the fields of energy, biotechnology and health by 2020.

As a sign of a desire to combine tradition and modernity, a project of linking lowland-mountain is in the pipeline and should soon connect the city of Sion to Veysonnaz and the «Piste de l'Ours».
