Information on import and export of rifles and ammunition

- National regulations
The transfer of firearms or ammunition across the state border is possible only at international border crossings.
Upon entering the Republic of Slovenia, you must immediately declare firearms and ammunition and show the firearms certificate to the authority conducting border controls (border police)
