Welcome to Östersund,

The Organizing Committee of the Östersund 2019 World Para Nordic Skiing World Cup extends our warmest invitation to participate in this event in Östersund, January 12th – 19th, 2019.

With a population of about 63 000, Östersund is the only city in the county of Jämtland. It is situated by the Lake Storsjön, in line with the coastal cities of Sundsvall and Trondheim (Norway). The mountain resort Åre is about an hour away, by car, while you get to Stockholm in 50 minutes, by air, and in less than five hours, by express train. The love of winter - enjoying it, as well as benefiting from it. The long, cold winter is the city's greatest asset, along with the freshest air and the cleanest water of Europe. Additional to the Biathlon World Championships 2008 and the annual Biathlon World Cup premiere, Östersund is also host of many other national and international winter sports events as Word Para Ice Hockey. And of course, the 2019 Biathlon World Championships.

Biathlon and Nordic skiing Stadium

City of Östersund continues to make many upgrades to the Ski stadium more than 89 kilometers of World class biathlon and cross-country racing trails at an average elevation. The Östersund World Para Nordic Skiing World Cup held at the Östersund Ski Stadium will be following a tradition of international Nordic events in the future hosted at this historic venue.

Climate

In middle of January we can expect nice but cold weather with sun and temperature from -5 to -30 degrees Celsius and there will be daylight from 09:30 to 15:00.

Arrival

At your arrival to Östersund/Åre Airport you will be meet by volunteers that will help you with the luggage and the transportation to the Hotel, a short bus ride for about maximum 5 minutes from the airport.

Hotel

You will be accommodated in twin rooms at Quality Hotel Frösö Park <u>www.frosoparkhotel.se</u> At the arrival to the Hotel your Team Manger will get the teams accreditation cards and room keys to hand out. Breakfast is served at the hotel, lunch will be served at the Ski stadium. Dinner will be served at the competition hotel. You will have free access to the gym facilitations and you will also have the possibility to use the Hotels own SPA for a reduced charge. Award Ceremony

The Award Ceremonies will be held straight after each category and competition at the competition area after official results are published. Three best will be awarded.

Facilities and Waxing

Transport to and from the arena must be ordered 24 hours in advance at the transport desk at the Hotel. It will take maximum 15 min to the Arena from the Hotel. To City center about 15 minutes. The local transportation between airport, hotel and Ski stadium is included to the accommodation fee.
