## Alpine Skiing History

### Origin Of Alpine Skiing

The roots of skiing go back to the Stone Age. Cave etchings of people on skis were discovered in Rodoy, Norway, and at the White Sea in Russia. Fragments of skis found in Sweden date back to 4,000 years ago, and it is believed that Norwegians used skis to hunt across snow-covered terrain more than 5,000 years ago.

From Norway, skiing expanded throughout Scandinavia and Russia, as a mode of winter transportation and eventually as a sport similar to cross-country skiing. Alpine skiing evolved from cross-country skiing.

### Alpine Ski Racing

The first known ski race for able-bodied athletes took place in 1850 outside Christiania, later known as Oslo, in Norway. Germany held its first ski race in 1879, and the first Swiss ski club was founded in Glaris in 1893. Several countries later formed ski associations, including Russia (1896), Czechoslovakia (1903), USA (1904), Austria (1905), Germany (1905), Norway (1908), Finland (1908) and Sweden (1908).

The International Ski Commission was formed in 1910, and the International Ski Federation (FIS) was founded during the 1924 Olympic Winter Games in Chamonix, France. However, alpine events were not included in the sport program until 1936, with the combined event. The slalom and downhill were added in 1948 in St. Moritz, and the giant slalom was introduced in Oslo in 1952.

### Alpine Skiing for the Disabled

Due to the Second World War, there were hundreds of young men in Austria and Germany with amputated limbs, many who were good skiers before their injuries. Above-knee amputees tried skiing with three skis. With one normal ski on the remaining leg and two short skis attached to crutches, the outriggers of modern skiing for the disabled were born.

In 1942, German Franz WENDL, who was injured in the war, was the first disabled person to participate in a ski competition with self-constructed outriggers. The first major competition for disabled skiers was held in 1948 at Wendelstein, with 70 amputees, and a slalom race for outrigger skiers was held in Bad Gastein, Austria. The first documented championships for the disabled were held in Bad Gastein in 1948, with 17 disabled athletes participating.

In 1949, the first World Winter Games for the Deaf were organized in Austria. By the end of the 1940s, the Austrian Ski Association had organized a department for the disabled. In 1960, Austrian equipment was used for the first outrigger skiing in the USA. In 1972, the first Norwegian championships for visually impaired skiers were held. That same year, the first unofficial world games for outrigger skiers were held in Courcheval, France. In 1974, the first official World Championships for the disabled were held in Grand Bornand, France.

In 1970, Widar JOHNSON created a plastic seat which enabled him to move in wintertime and play ice hockey and enjoy cross-country skiing. In 1980 in Japan, a chair ski association created the basis for the modern mono-ski. In recent years, the adjustable suspension for mono-skis has caused a technical revolution.

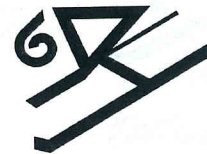
### Alpine Skiing at the Paralympic Winter Games

The Paralympic Winter Games have been held in the same location as the Olympic Winter Games since 1992 in Albertville. At the VI Paralympic Winter Games in Lillehammer, the disabled athletes stayed in the Olympic Village and could benefit, for the first time, from the same infrastructure as the Olympic athletes.

### Alpine Skiing in USA

The Norwegian skis were brought to the USA by emigrants who crossed the Atlantic as early as 1825. Sondre NORHEIM, who came from Telemark county in south Norway and was a pioneer in reviving interest in skiing as a sport in the late 17th century, emigrated in 1884. He was among those who promoted the sport of skiing in the USA.

The first ski association in the USA was founded in 1904. By the 1920s, America had at most three sites for learning to ski



## Alpine Skiing Competition Description

As of 10 MAR 2002

### Paralympic Competition Format

The ranking in all alpine skiing events is based on the ascending cumulated times. In the Paralympic Winter Games, men and ladies compete in four disciplines:

#### Events

Downhill	One run determines the finishing order (for weather, safety and other reasons, the jury can decide to have a two-run downhill).
Super-G	One run
Giant Slalom	Two runs. Start list for the first run is reversed for the second run. The course is reset for the second run.
Slalom	Two runs. Start list for the first run is reversed for the second run. The course is reset for the second run.

If there are more than 120 competitors entered in race, only 80 percent of the start list entries are allowed to start the second run.

#### Differences Between the Olympic Games and the Paralympic Games

Unique to the Paralympics is the classification system that enables athletes to compete on an equal level. All athletes compete with a pre-determined degree of disability.

Classification is based on the functional abilities of competitors according to the degree and type of disabilities. Competitors with similar disabilities compete against one another in the same class in a given event. Winter sports are largely divided into three categories: LW classes (LW stands for locomotor winter and represents competitors with locomotive disabilities), sitting LW classes and B classes (competitors with visual impairment). Classification is conducted and determined by IPC-authorized classifiers.

Classes will be combined when there are too few competitors per class. The classes will be combined within the categories standing LW1-9 classes, sitting LW10-12 classes and B classes. When classes are combined, a percentage system will be used to calculate results, taking the actual time and multiplying it by a percentage based on the competitors class. Combined classes will be determined at the team captains meetings held before the competition.

Visually impaired athletes (B1-3) start first, followed by the sit-ski athletes (LW10-12) and the standing athletes (LW1-9). The order in which the individual events within these three categories will be run is determined by jury decision on the day of competition. Within each class, the start order for the first run is according to the draw held at the team captains meeting on the evening before the event.

If, based on jury decision, there are sufficient athletes in any one event in the slalom and giant slalom, the bottom 20 percent of the athletes who finish the first run will be eliminated from the second run.

#### Tie-Break Rules and Procedures

No tie-break rules and procedures -- skiers who have identical accumulated finish times share their rank.

#### Penalties / Disqualification Rules

There are no penalties. Disqualification rules are defined in the IPC/FIS rules. The disqualification of each competitor has to be confirmed by the jury.



## Alpine Skiing Qualification Criteria

As of 10 MAR 2002

### Participation

Only those National Paralympic Committees (NPCs) recognized by the International Paralympic Committee (IPC) may enter competitions in the Paralympic Games. A country without membership in the IPC has to become a member before it is permitted to take part in the Paralympic Games.

### Eligible for competition

All those who meet the alpine medical classifications (see alpine skiing classification rules) are eligible for competition.

All classes are allowed to compete in all alpine disciplines (downhill, super-G, giant slalom and slalom).

### Class Quotas

A nation may enter a maximum of three (3) competitors per class per event (downhill, super-G, giant slalom and slalom).

To be valid for competition, the class (event) must have a minimum six entries and four countries represented.

When there are too few competitors in a class, the class will be combined with another class. The combination of classes follows specific rules, and the athletes are given specific percentages, according to decisions made by the alpine sports assembly.

### Qualification System

The maximum number of athletes eligible to compete in the alpine events at the Paralympic Winter Games is 260 (190 male athletes and 70 female).

To qualify for the speed events (downhill, super-G), an athlete must have obtained a maximum of 300 Disabled FIS points by 7 January 2002. Athletes who qualify in one speed event are eligible for entry in all four alpine disciplines downhill, super-G, giant slalom and slalom.

To qualify for the technical events (giant slalom, slalom), an athlete must have obtained an individual result in an IPC/FIS-sanctioned competition between 1 March 1998 and 7 January 2002.

No consideration will be given for qualification after 7 January 2002.

If an NPC does not qualify athletes by the above process, the NPC may enter one male and/or one female athlete, providing it can be verified that the athlete(s) is of appropriate caliber.

### Special Considerations

The IPC Alpine Sports Assembly Executive Committee reserves the right to evaluate, verify and approve all entries on the basis of performance, qualification, classification and safety within the technical rules and guidelines of the IPC and FIS rules.



## Alpine Skiing Classification Rules

As of 10 MAR 2002

Class	Description
B1	No light perception in either eye up to light perception, but inability to recognize the shape of a hand at any distance or in any direction.
B2	From ability to recognize the shape of a hand up to visual acuity of 2/60 and/or visual field of less than 5 degrees.
B3	From visual acuity above 2/60 up to visual acuity of 6/60 and/or visual field of more than 5 degrees and less than 20 degrees.
LW1	Athletes with severe disabilities in both lower limbs.
LW2	Athletes with severe disabilities in one lower limb.
LW3	Athletes with disabilities in both lower limbs skiing with two normal skis and two poles or two stabilizers. See 3/1 and 3/2.
LW3/1	Athletes with double below the knee amputation, and those with disabilities in both lower limbs with maximum of 60 muscle points. Skiing with 1 or 2 skis and 2 poles or stabilizers.
LW3/2	Athletes with cerebral palsy who have moderate to slight diplegic involvement, or moderate athetoid or atactic impairment. Skiing with 1 or 2 skis and 2 poles or stabilizers.
LW4	Athletes with disabilities in one lower limb, skiing with two skis and two poles.
LW5/7	Athletes with disabilities in both upper limbs, skiing with two normal skis and without poles.
LW6/8	Athletes with disabilities in one upper limb, skiing with two normal skis and one pole. The disability must be such that the functional use of more than one pole is not possible.
LW9	Athletes with disabilities in one upper limb and one lower limb skiing with equipment of their choice. See 9/1 and 9/2.
LW9/1	Athletes with disabilities in one upper limb and one lower limb above knee amputation or comparable disability; or CP7 athletes with severe hemiplegia. Skiing with equipment of their choice.
LW9/2	Athletes with disabilities in one upper limb and one lower limb below knee amputation or comparable disability; or CP7 athletes with minimal or moderate to slight hemiplegia.
LW10	Athletes with disabilities in lower limbs, no functional sitting balance. Athletes with Cerebral Palsy with disabilities in all four limbs.
LW11	Athletes with disabilities in lower limbs and a fair sitting balance. Athletes with Cerebral Palsy with disabilities in lower extremities. Skiing with a sitski of their choice.
LW12	Athletes with disabilities in the lower limbs and a good sitting balance. Skiing with a sitski of their choice. See 12/1 and 12/2
LW12/1	Athletes with spinal cord lesion or other disabilities.
LW12/2	Athletes with amputations in the lower limbs.

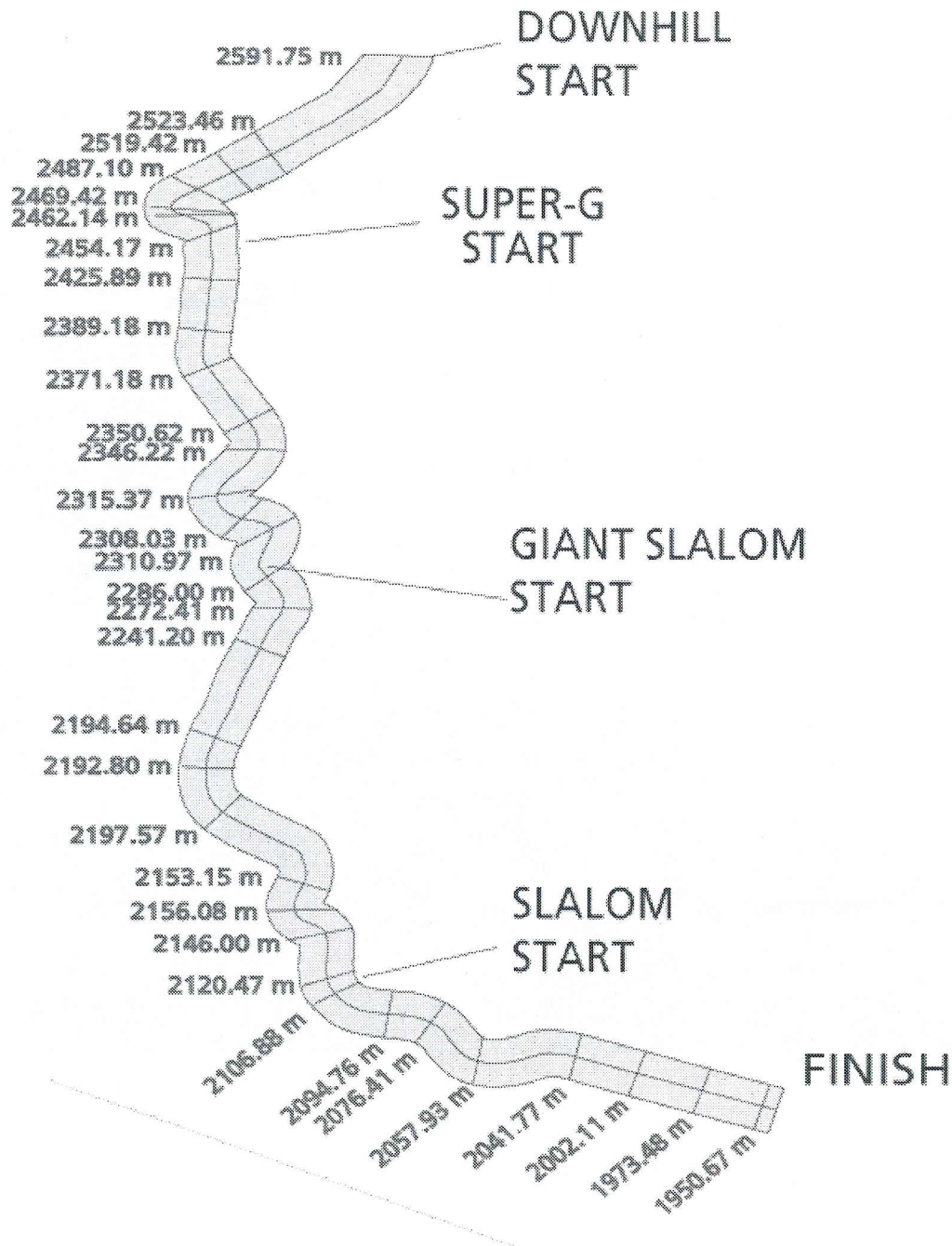


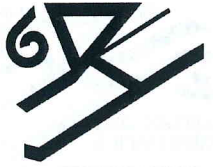

Snowbasin

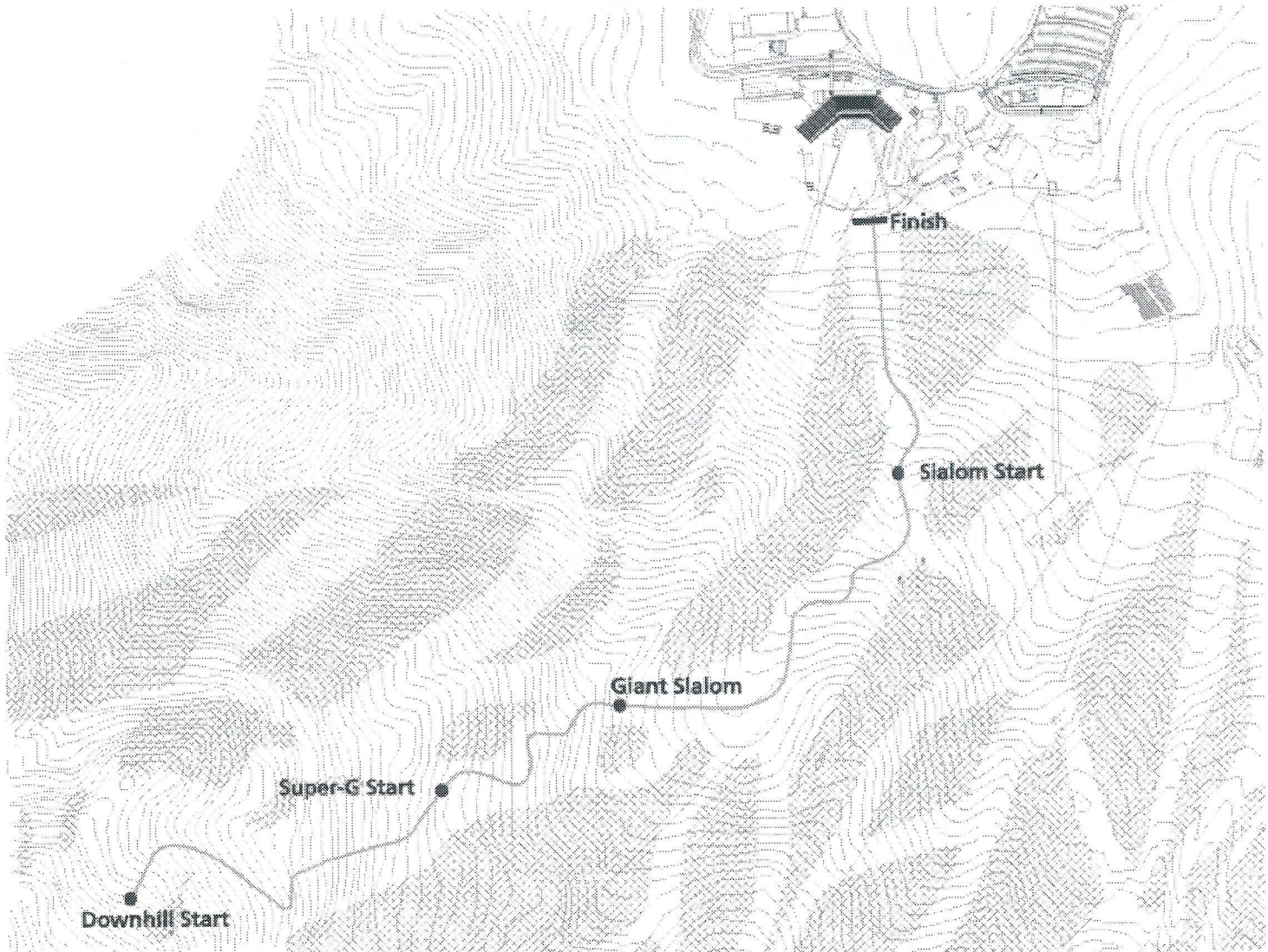
Course Map

As of 10 MAR 2002



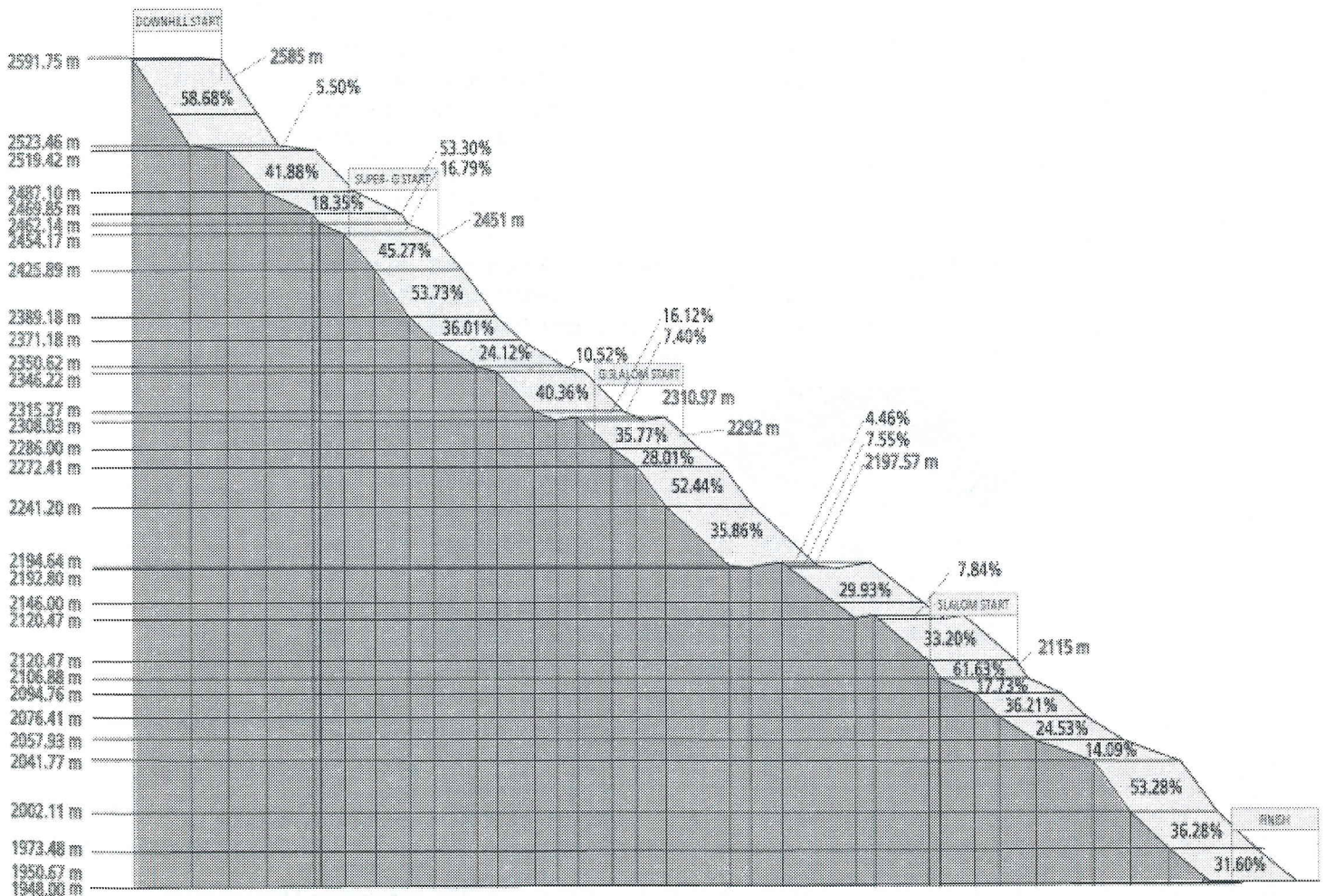

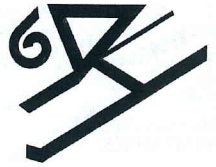

As of 10 MAR 2002





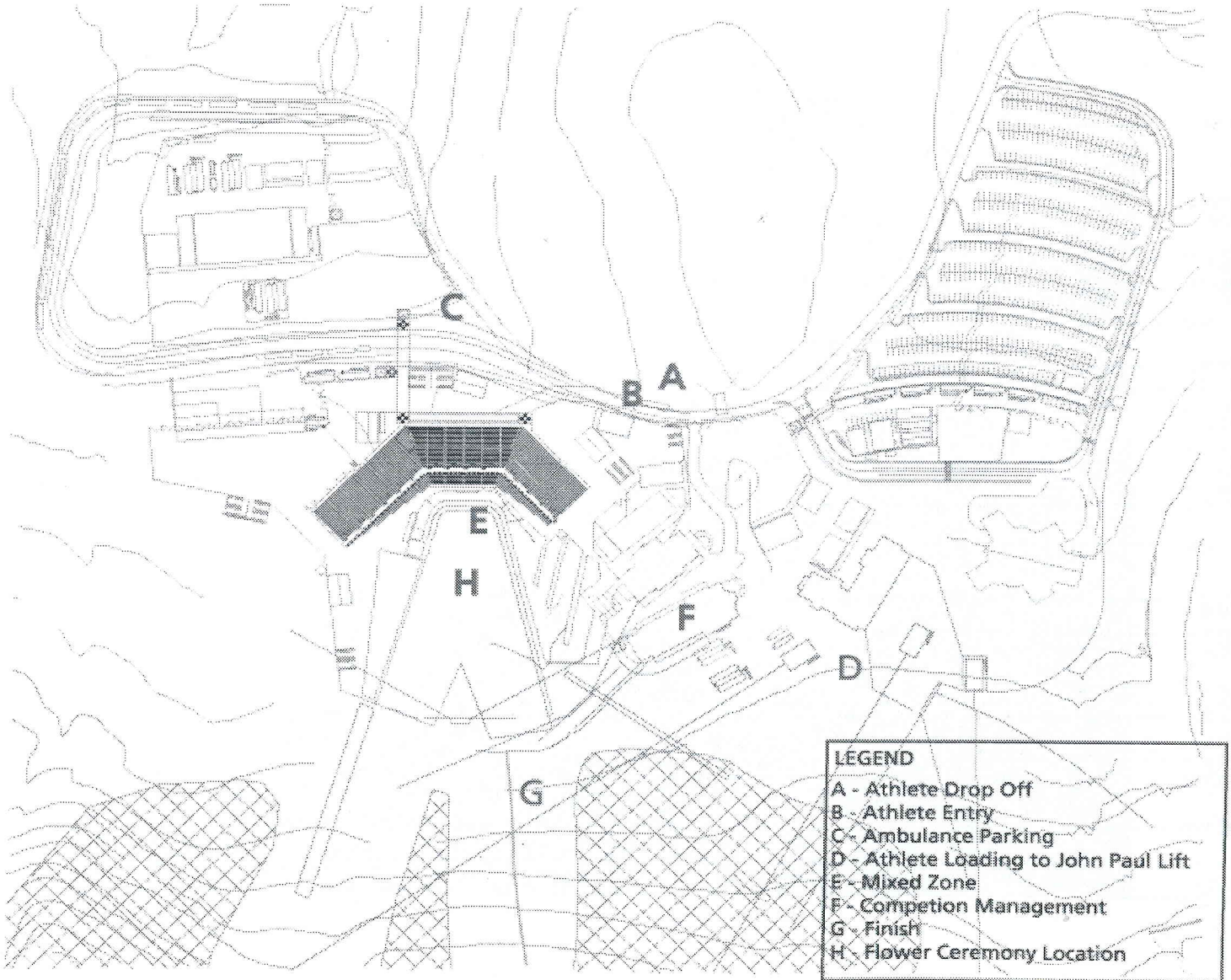
