Ice Sledge Hockey History

Origin Of Ice Hockey

Ancient people in northern climates adapted to a land of snow and ice. Over 2000 years ago, people traveled quickly across the ice on reindeer bones connected to foot coverings, and this primitive skate provided an effective means of transportation. Eventually the ice skate was prized as a recreational tool and became the basis for a variety of ice sheet sports.

In Windsor, Ontario, Canada, in 1788, the boys at King's College School adapted the Irish field game of hurley to the ice of Long Pond, their favorite skating pond, and created "ice hurley," which developed into ice hockey as it is known today. Hurley is a field game played year-round in Ireland with a ball and sticks. During a 50-year period, the game was referred to by many names, including hurley, ricket and wicket. For many years, an undocumented story around Windsor told of Colonel HOCKEY, an English officer stationed at Fort Edward, whose troops had played ice hurley. It soon became known as "Hockey's game," and eventually simply hockey. The first set of rules specifying a puck -- a flat piece of wood -- were written in 1837.

Ice Hockey At Olympic Winter Games

Ice hockey made its first Olympic appearance at the Summer Games in Antwerp in 1920, four years before the first Winter Games were held. Hockey was part of the program in 1924, when the inaugural Olympic Winter Games were held in Chamonix.

Canada dominated the Olympic Winter Games until the appearance of the Soviet Union in 1956. Since then the former Soviet Union (Russia) has won most of the gold medals. The Games in Nagano marked the first time professional players from the National Hockey League (NHL) suspended their league play to participate in the Olympic Winter Games. The Czech Republic is the defending Olympic gold medalist, with Russia taking silver and Finland capturing the bronze medal.

Ice Sledge Hockey At Paralympic Winter Games

Ice sledge hockey is an offshoot of the game of ice hockey. It has existed for more than 30 years. In 1988, it was a demonstration event for the paralyzed at the Innsbruck Paralympic Winter Games. In 1992 at Tignes-Albertville, ice sports such as sledge racing and ice sledge hockey were not included in the Paralympic sport program due to a lack of facilities. Ice sledge hockey made its Paralympic debut in 1994 in Lillehammer and continued in Nagano.

Ice Sledge Hockey In USA

In 1990, sledge hockey was introduced in the USA. It languished as a sport, however, until 1996, when a national team was finally organized. The U.S. ice sledge team went to Nagano in 1998 for its first appearance in the Paralympic Winter Games, placing sixth out of seven teams.

Women And Ice Sledge Hockey

Women are welcome to the game. At sledge hockey's Paralympic debut in Lillehammer in 1994, a 49-year-old woman was on the roster as a goaltender. In fact, coed teams are common in sports for the disabled.

Ice Sledge Hockey Competition Description

As of 10 MAR 2002

Paralympic Competition Format

The ice sledge hockey competition will take place at the E Center. Ice sledge hockey is similar to ice hockey. Each team is composed of 15 players, including two goaltenders. Only 12 players may dress for each game. Athletes use sledges with two blades that allow the puck to pass underneath and picks to propel themselves and to move the puck across the ice. As with ice hockey, each team has five players on the ice plus a goalie.

Six teams will take part in the men's Paralympic ice sledge hockey tournament: Canada, Estonia, Japan, Norway, Sweden and USA. Games are played as three 15-minute, stop-time periods. There are two phases: preliminary round and playoffs.

Preliminary Round

All teams will participate in the preliminary round. The preliminary games will be a round-robin format with each of the six teams playing each team once (five games each). Points will be awarded on the following basis:

- *Two (2) points for a win
- *One (1) point for a tie
- *Zero (0) points for a loss

Final Round

Final round games will be based on total points earned. The top two teams play in the gold medal final, teams three and four play in the bronze final and the remaining two teams play in the fifth-place game.

Differences Between Olympic Winter Games and Paralympic Winter Games

Ice sledge hockey competitors have lower limb disabilities, meaning clearly and easily recognized permanent disabilities in the lower limbs (athletes who are unable to skate or play ice hockey under ordinary circumstances). Each competitor on a bladed "sledge" propels the sledge forward using sticks held in each hand. The sticks are also used to shoot and pass the puck, which is able to roll underneath the sledge.

Tiebreak Rules and Procedures

If there are two or more teams with equal points in the preliminary round, the teams will be ranked according to the following rules:

1. The ranking will be determined by the results of head-to-head competition between the two teams.
2. If the teams are still tied, goal differential will be used to determine the ranking. Each team's total of goals against will be deducted from the team's total of goals scored, and the team with the higher goal differential will earn the higher ranking.

In playoffs, if a game is tied at the end of the three regulation periods, a 10-minute sudden-victory overtime period will be played. If the game is still tied, penalty shots will determine the winner.

Penalties/Disqualification Rules

There is a wide variety of penalties that can be called during an ice sledge hockey game. A player can be penalized for 2, 2+2 (double minor), 5, 10 and 10+2 minutes. After these penalties are called, the game continues according to IIHF rules, and the player returns to the ice after the penalty time has been served.

Protests

Protests must be submitted in writing to the Directorate Jury, in English, within one hour after competition of the game.

Ice Sledge Hockey Qualification Criteria

As of 15 MAR 2002

Participation

Only those NPCs recognized by the IPC may enter competition in the Paralympic Games. A country without IPC membership must become a member before it is permitted to participate in the Paralympic Games.

Eligible For Competition

Athletes eligible for competition are all athletes with locomotion disabilities in the lower part of the body.

*All athletes must qualify through the qualification system as defined by the IPC.

*The athlete must have an impairment of permanent nature in the lower part of the body of such a degree that it is obvious and easily recognizable and makes ordinary skating and consequently ice hockey playing impossible.

*Minimum disability is regarding: amputation (through the ankle); paresis (loss of 10 muscle points in both legs, not counting grade 1 and 2, with maximal point score 80); joint mobility (ankylosis/fusion of the ankle joint); extension defect of at least 30 degrees or ankylosis of knee point; CP (spastically/disco-ordination corresponding to CP class 7); leg shortening (at least 7 centimeters).

Normal upper body function is expected. Any impairment in upper body does not affect requirements of minimum disability in lower body. Athletes with hip joint disorders only i.e. restricted mobility are not expected to participate in ice sledge hockey and are not eligible for the Paralympic Winter Games. Athletes without required minimum disability but who cannot play regular ice hockey because of chronic post-traumatic painful disorders, instability of ankle or knee joints or similar conditions, are not eligible.

Quotas

A maximum of 15 players, including two goaltenders, will make up the playing team listed on the official game sheet, but only 12 players per team may dress for each game.

For ice sledge competition to be valid, a minimum of four countries must be represented. If there are fewer than four countries, the tournament will be canceled.

Qualification System

The number of teams competing in the 2002 ice sledge tournament is six. The maximum number of athletes is 90. The maximum number of ice sledge hockey athletes per NPC is 15.

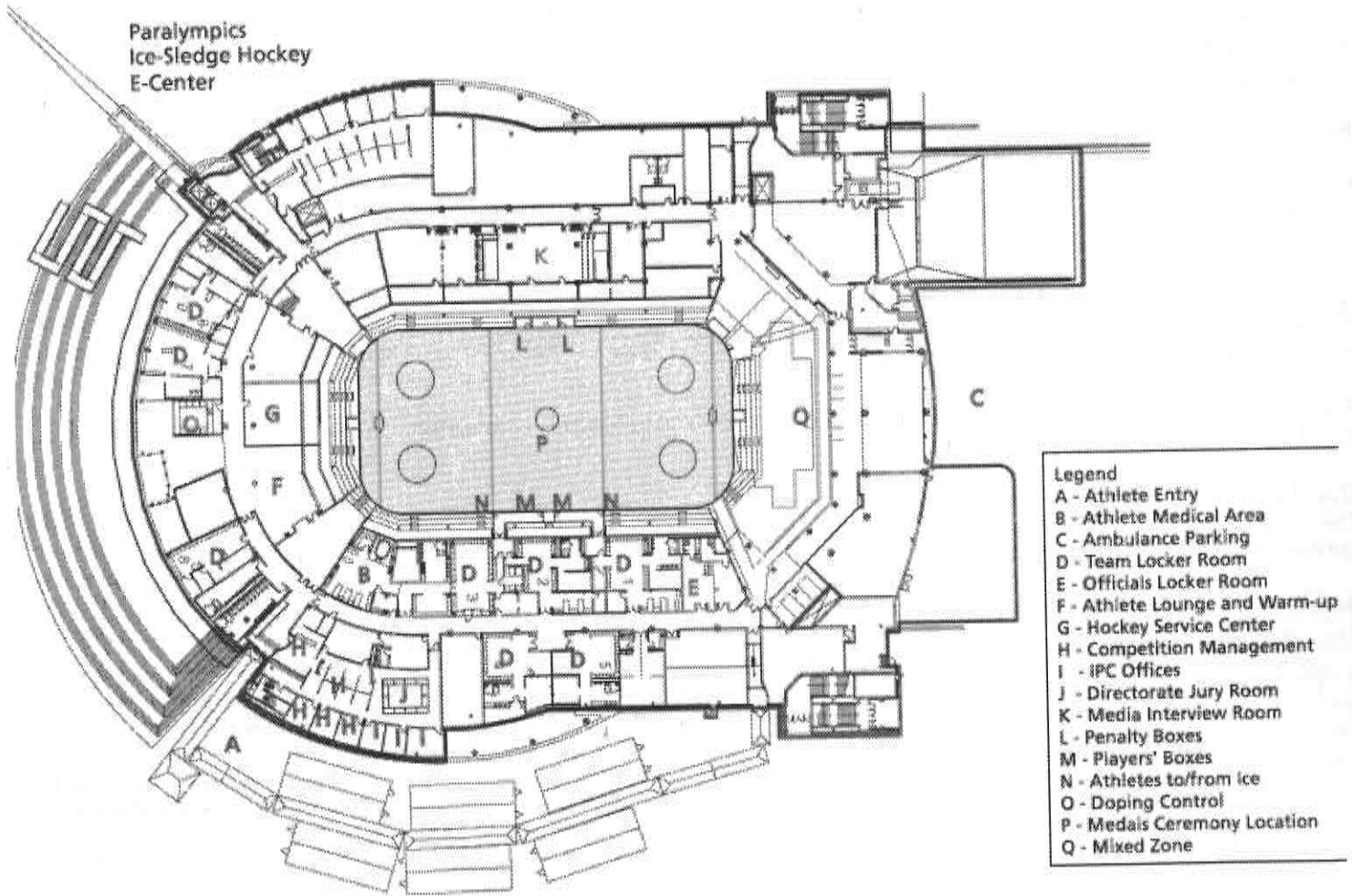
